Dr. Suzanne McCluskey an Assistant in Medicine in the Massachusetts General Hospital, Division of Infectious Diseases. Her research focuses on the epidemiology and management of HIV treatment failure and antiretroviral drug resistance in resource-limited settings with projects based in Mbarara, Uganda and KwaZulu Natal, South Africa. Her current work aims to explore novel strategies to more accurately differentiate between patients failing therapy with resistant versus wild-type virus and to evaluate the impact of HIV drug resistance and adherence patterns on the effectiveness of dolutegravir-based antiretroviral therapy regimens in sub-Saharan Africa.
