He is the head of the Division of Molecular Biology and Human Genetics, Executive Head of the Department of Biomedical Sciences, holds a NRF SARChI award and has been awarded a Distinguished Professor title for a second term. His research focuses on the immunology of Mycobacterium tuberculosis (MTB) infection and in particular host biomarkers.
